

2008/2009 Code Of Conduct
And Drug & Alcohol Policy
For PCCT Junior & Senior High Youth Group Programs

Each student is expected to abide by these rules of conduct:

- No possession or use of alcohol, drugs or tobacco
- No fighting, weapons, fireworks, lighters, or explosives
- No offensive or immodest clothing
- No boys in girls' sleeping quarters and no girls in boys' sleeping quarters
- Participation with the group is expected
- No put-downs - Respect one another, staff, and adult and student leaders
- Respect the property of the church and others
- Respect and comply with event schedules

Church representatives and/or activity leaders retain the right to take whatever actions they deem necessary and appropriate, which MAY INCLUDE one or more of the following with respect to a youth member of the church or his/her invited guest(s):

1. Notify the offender's parent(s) or guardian(s)
2. Send the offender(s) home
3. Notify all the parent(s) and guardian(s)
4. End the activity and send all the participants home
5. Search all personal belongings
6. Notify the police
7. Forfeiture of monies paid to participate in event(s)
8. Expulsion from group for the balance of the year

In addition, group activities at locations other than our church property may also have policies that supersede our own and need to be respected by any youth attending our church's events at those locations.
