

## Confirmation Class of 2010 Discipleships

Christian discipleship is following the example of Jesus Christ. Jesus taught his disciples to go out into the world to love and serve others. He emphasized that leading by example is the most powerful way to influence others and to be personally effected.

Discipleships are opportunities for each student to follow the example of Jesus Christ through participating in the life/ministry of PCCT. Discipleships teach the students that being a disciple is an active process. Discipleships also teach that being part of a Christian community involves participation in the life and ministry of Jesus Christ.

Each student is asked to either choose an area to serve as a disciple or accumulate 10 discipleship credits by January, 2009, if possible.

This can be accomplished by:

- Participating in an area of PCCT ministry (70% attendance-10 credits).

  - ❖ SCEEP- Saturday 9:00am-noon
  - ❖ Chancel Choir
  - ❖ Manna Project Band
  - ❖ Sunday School Teacher's Aide- Sunday 9:15am
  
- Participating in mission opportunities offered through various PCCT ministries. Discipleship opportunities include:
  - ❖ Community Soup Kitchen- Cook/buy food and place in the kitchen freezer prior to the fourth Thursday of the month (1 credit).
  - ❖ Community Soup Kitchen- Serve food at the CSK leaving PCCT at 10:00 am on the fourth Thursday of the month (2 credits).
  - ❖ Hospitality Network- Assist with set-up (2 credits) or take-down (1 credit).
  - ❖ Provide Childcare for a Church Event- Babysitting for younger children during the Fall Fellowship Series and Holiday Services (2 credits).
  - ❖ Hillside Food Bank- Sort food and supplies at the foodbank leaving PCCT at 8:00 am on the third Saturday of the month (3 credits).
  - ❖ Morris County Habitat for Humanity- Building homes on worksite. Dates TBA (5 credits).
  - ❖ Pumpkin Patch Mission Project- Assist with distribution of pumpkins in October (Credits TBD).
  - ❖ Create and develop your own ministry for the church- Speak with Rev. Oehler before end of September (credits TBD).

We ask each confirmand to decide by the end of September what areas he/she will serve as a disciples this year and to communicate this to Reverend Oehler.

It is also the confirmand's responsibility to notify the discipleship contact person at least a few days prior to the event to find out the relevant details for completing the discipleship. After the discipleship activity is completed, participation information should be forwarded to the parent coordinators. It is the confirmand's responsibility to make sure that the participation credits are kept current and are completed by January, 2009.
